**Mill on the Brue, Bruton, Somerset – 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> June 2020 – Cost: £380**

It is a full-on week of water-based activities, led by qualified instructors from the centre. All children taking part in this trip must be confident in the water and should be able to swim 50 metres.
