Music Celebration 2023 Invitation to perform

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are planning for our annual Music Celebration to take place on the evenings of Monday 27th and Tuesday 28th March 2023.

Choir and orchestra members will be expected to attend and perform on both evenings. We will also be holding auditions this term for our Concert Singers group, who will perform on both evenings.

If your child learns to play an instrument in school, their teacher will let them know if they think they are ready to perform at the concert. Those children will perform on either the Monday or Tuesday evening. We will confirm which evening they will perform at the beginning of Term 4.

If your child learns to play a musical instrument outside of school or has singing lessons, and they would like to perform in our concert, please complete the form below. We are not sure at present how many "acts" we will be able to include, so we cannot guarantee at this point that we will be able to include everyone who applies. However, those acts that don't make it to the whole school concert will be able to show their pieces to their class.

Children who apply will be asked to send in an audition performance, filmed at home, by the end of Term 3, 10th February. If that is not possible, we can arrange for them to audition in school on Tuesday 7th February. The audition will help us to plan a balanced programme, with a range of instruments and a range of abilities.

If we have too many to choose from, we may give preference to older children who have not performed in one of our concerts before, as they may not get another chance before they leave primary school.
